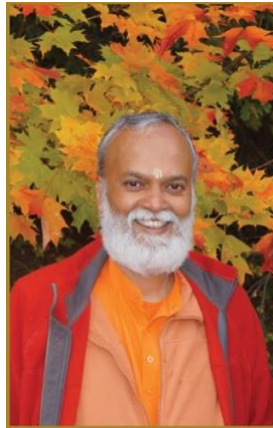


"SPECIAL QUALITY"

Swami Chidatmananda is a spiritual teacher from Hyderabad, India, who emphasizes the oneness (non-duality) of all beings. He is an Acharya (Teacher in Charge) of Chinmaya Mission, an outgrowth of the life-long dedication and teachings of the renowned Vedantic Master, H.H. Swami Chinmayananda.

Swamiji will speak on: 1. Special Qualities are standards of Beliefs and Values that guide Conduct, Behavior and Activities; 2. Dependence on the Divine Self, feeling always surrounded by Unlimited, Unconditional, Unchanging Love; 3. Perseverance, Determined Effort, Hard Work and Single-Minded Devotion leads to the Achievement of selected Goals; 4. Forgiveness - a key to making Love Unconditional is the Willingness to Forgive; 6. Good Conduct destroys of all Bad Habits.

Swami Chidatmananda committed his life to spiritual service in 1989, after graduating from law school. He is well-known on Indian television, where he illumines the meaning of ancient Hindu scriptures for modern times. He conducts sessions for government organizations, management schools, and medical clinics.
